# PLACE OF PROCESSING

# **DATA PROCESSORS**

#### **METHODS OF PROCESSING**

This Privacy Notice applies to the personal data submitted by the user (technically: the data subject) when completing the "Contact" section of the website. In accordance with Article 5 of the GDPR, your personal data will be processed lawfully, fairly, and transparently; collected for specified, explicit, and legitimate purposes; and processed in a manner compatible with those purposes. The data will be adequate, relevant, and limited to what is necessary; accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date; stored in a form that permits identification of data subjects; and processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage, using suitable technical and organizational measures.

# **DATA RETENTION PERIOD**

The data collected will be processed for the purpose of managing your requests and will be retained for a limited period corresponding to the time required to process and respond to your inquiries, or until a request for erasure is submitted by the data subject.

# **RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT**

Data subjects have the rights set out in Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 20 and 21 of the GDPR, including the right to access their personal data, request rectification, updating, erasure, restriction of processing if the data are incomplete, inaccurate, or unlawfully collected, as well as the right to data portability and to object to processing carried out on legitimate grounds.
